WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Students in 8th grade or 14 yrs old through 12th grade or 18 years old. These should be the students who are currently leaders in your youth or congregational ministry or who show an interest in serving as a leader in your congregational setting or in their community. You know best who your leaders are! Consider sending both younger and older students.

WE WANT TO SEND 1 OR 2 STUDENTS FROM OUR CONGREGATION, BUT.....

If you have just a few students wanting to attend and are not able to send an adult with them, team up with another local congregation or other district congregation. Please make sure to identify who from the other congregation will be the responsible party for your youth. A parent and student could also come on their own and consider this a college visit (one free adult registration will still be honored per family group). District schools are also welcome to send students.



WHAT WILL WE DO?

Participate in a local service project and receive service hour credit. Attend sessions on leadership topics led by speakers invited by CUNE as well as University faculty, staff and students. Different sessions available for parents to attend on topics relevant to them such as College 101 and Understanding Financial Aid. See and tour campus as well as have the opportunity to attend a class. Receive a certificate of documentation of your service hours as well as a certificate of completion for private scholarship applications.

WHY IS THIS EVENT SCHEDULED IN OCTOBER DURING SCHOOL?

In 2018 both CUNE and Oklahoma schools had different Fall Breaks; however, this year they line up on the same weekend. The organizers of C.L.A.S.S. felt that having this event while the campus was active was a vital part of the event so that the students attending get a real taste of "college life" while on campus.

We know that many high school students may be able to qualify the event as a "college visit" and receive an excused absence. Speak to your high school counselor about this opportunity. We will also have campus tours available and a special session for parents of students related to college admissions.
