


Braille Brigade---CTR's Braille volunteers will resume production on Monday, September 9th with sessions at 9:00 and 12:30



Can you spare 3 hours once a month in service to the Lord? We need additional volunteers to help in the production of Braille books of the Bible. CTR's Braille Brigade meets on the first Monday of each month, usually breaking for the summer. Sessions are from 9-12:00 and 12:30-3:00 and we have openings available in each session. Jobs include numbering pages, punching holes in the pages for binding, "stuffing" pages in aluminum plates, passing the plates through a press that prints Braillle on both sides of the page (that's amazing!), assembling the pages into books, printing cover pages, and boxing the books for mailing. Some of jobs require standing while others allow you to sit, and we often switch jobs after our break. A minimum of 8 people is needed for each session to operate in the most efficient manner. We fellowship with one another while we volunteer, sharing laughs while we do God's work. Please prayerfully consider joining us in this effort to bring the word of God to the blind and visually impaired throughout the world.



Peace Choir


1st-5th Grade Wednesdays, 6:00 pm Sundays, 9:40 am



Who can attend?

To register for the 2025 Gathering, youth participants must meet ONE of the two following eligibility requirements:

- Must be 14 years old at the time of the Gatherina OR
- Entering his or her ninth-grade year at the time of the Gathering.



When is it?

Gathering dates are July 19-23, 2025. Please keep open July 17-24 at this time as we make travel and special event arrangements. Once the dates are firm, we will update that information.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

Our registration MUST be mailed on November 1, 2024 to meet the early deadline. Beforehand, we need each student to complete the necessary registration form as well as receive signatures from a parent and our Pastor. Early Registration is \$395 per person. If you choose to attend after November 1, 2025 your cost is \$475 per person.

Early Registration Pay Schedule:

A \$175 non-refundable deposit per person is due by August 25 or you may pay the full \$395.

A second payment of \$120 is due by December 31. A third and final payment of \$100 is due by March 1.

Late Registration Pay Schedule:

A \$275 non-refundable deposit per person is due by upon registration or you may pay the full \$475.

A second payment of \$100 is due by December 31. A third and final payment of \$100 is due by March 1.

Once you commit to going you are responsible for any costs associated with you going on the trip that the church pays in your name. If you decide at a later date to not go, you must find someone to take your place or you will be responsible for reimbursing Christ the Redeemer for any funds paid in your name above your registration fee. This includes: hotel costs, transportation costs, special event tickets, t-shirts, etc.


