Fellow Redeemed.

October is a month rich in color, memory, and meaning. As leaves turn and seasons shift, we are reminded of the ongoing transformation all around us, and within us. For us, October also brings a special moment to remember the Reformation, sparked on October 31, 1517, when Martin Luther nailed his 95 Theses to the church door in Wittenberg. It was more than a protest; it was a call to return to the heart of the gospel: salvation by grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone.

But the Reformation wasn't just a historical event. It's a continuing reality.

Reformation is not only something we look back on; it's something we live.

As Luther himself wrote, "When our Lord and Master Jesus Christ said, 'Repent,' he willed the entire life of believers to be one of repentance." In other words, personal reform is real, lasting change that doesn't come through sheer willpower or external improvement. It begins and continues through daily repentance and the daily reception of God's grace.

Each day, we wake to a fresh invitation: lay down the weight of sin, pride, and self-sufficiency, and take hold of the mercy that Christ freely offers. God's grace is not a one-time gift; it is a constant stream, poured out through the cross and present in every moment by the power of the Holy Spirit.

This October, as we reflect on the bold courage of the Reformers, let's also rejoice in the quiet, courageous work God is doing in each of our hearts. Through repentance, we are re-formed and reshaped into the image of Christ. Through grace, we are renewed and strengthened to live as forgiven people who extend forgiveness, mercy, and love to others.

So let the colors of fall remind you: God is always at work transforming what is old into something new. Let the Reformation remind you: this change isn't about what we achieve, but what we receive.

And let every day begin with this prayer:

"Lord, reform me again by Your Word, by Your Spirit, by Your grace."

Amen!



Thank you! Thank you for sending your youth and their leaders to volunteer with us at the Youth Gathering in New Orleans. They were truly a joy to work with. We wanted you to know how much the Forged by Fire team appreciated their devotion and service.

In those short three days of service, they helped us prepare and serve around 9,000 meals for those attending the gathering. It was extremely hot and humid those three days. Honestly, it was about the worst conditions the great state of Louisiana could have thrown at you. Yet your youth and their leaders didn't let it stop them!

For our indoor service event, they packed close to 600 shelf stable food boxes that have been distributed to local LCMS congregations to help their communities. The impact for those individuals who received these boxes in their time of need cannot be measured. Thank you!

In total, we had over 450 youth volunteers, their leaders, and YAV volunteers. With over 1,000 volunteer hours logged in that short time, it is easy for us to say that you were amazing! We cannot stress enough that we could have not done this without your help.

We hope this experience was valuable to them and they learned more about how Forged by Fire and LCMS Disaster Response teams respond in mercy to those in need, sharing the love of Jesus Christ. Dear friends and supporters of our ministry to Germany and across Eurasia!

For some of us, it's back to school. Well, maybe not for us personally, but perhaps for our kid or grandkids...But in my case, I get to go back to school as a theological instructor of the "English stream" of Riga Luther Academy, Latvia—the online seminary supported by the LCMS. Enrollment this fall is at an all-time high, with a total of 44 students and 18 freshmen: 11 from Africa and 7 from Europe. I will once again teach two courses per week: Overview of the Bible, a 20-week course that extends into March, and Overview of Practical Theology, which goes until Christmas. I greatly appreciate that I can work with people brand-new to Christianity (that is, our Persians in Hamburg) and also have the privilege of being one of the instructors who guide mature Christians on their four and a half journey to ordination. Some of our seminarians have been pastors for years, but wish to enhance their understanding of historic Christianity faithful to Scripture, while most of them are laymen. For all of our courses, the requirements are the same: for each lesson, read a copious amount, watch a roughly 60-minute video, work through the handout, and take a quiz on that particular lesson. And all of that times four or five per week for the various courses. Quite a workload for men who are juggling jobs and family obligations at the same time. Classes for the new school year start today, on August 25. And so, for the past few weeks, I have been preparing for "back to school"—recording videos and writing handouts and quizzes. At the same time, the Persian ministry goes on. We recently started a new 12-week Baptismal class, with currently six candidates, and I continue to lead the Farsi-language Divine Service and preach in Farsi, sometimes taking turns with my Finnish missionary colleague Rev. Pasi Palmu, about whom I write in this month's newsletter. Thank you all for keeping the Tiews going out here on the mission field, and praise God for the many ways in which He is blessing His work that we are privileged to do!


